Please attach your name to each article submitted.

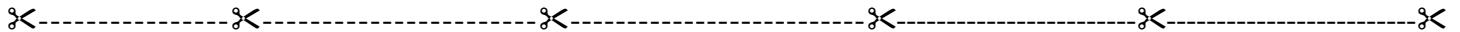

Loom & Shuttle Guild, begun in 1948 meets bi-monthly in San Francisco. Our meetings feature a program - usually an outside speaker - as well as a time for members to share projects, problems and discoveries.

Study Groups are open to all members, we meet regularly to learn more about various weaving and related techniques. The guild also sponsors speakers and workshops with noted experts in the field of textile arts.

The guild has a large library featuring not only books but also pamphlets and monographs (both new and out-of-print volumes), sample books from various study groups and a variety of magazines, including Handwoven, Shuffle, Spindle & Dyepot, Weavers, and Threads. Any guild member may borrow library materials. Books may be borrowed by contacting the Librarian for an appointment or books may be requested and picked up at regular LOOM & SHUTTLE GUILD meetings and returned at the following meeting. Four books may be taken out for no longer than two months. Lost books must be replaced or paid for in full. A fine of \$1.00 per month will be assessed for each overdue book.
